Proceedings of the 41st Annual General Body Meeting of the Alumni Association, UAS, Bengaluru – 560024 for the year 2023-24 held on 29th March 2025 at 11.00 a.m. at Prof G.K. Veeresh Auditorium, Alumni Association, UAS, Hebbal, Bengaluru.

1. Welcome

The Members of the General body assembled at 11.00 A.M. and the President noticed that there was only 136 members present which was not satisfying the quorum, as the requirement was 1/3rd of the total number of members as per the bylaw. Hence, in the absence of quorum, the President adjourned the AGB Meeting to meet to 11.30 a.m.

The Members of the General body re-assembled at 11.30 a.m. and with no further improvement in the quorum, the President Dr. H.L. Harish declared the AGM open and requested the Secretary, Dr. K.M. Harinikumar to initiate with the agenda items. The Joint Secretary, Dr. S. Chandrashekhar extending warm welcome to the President, Office bearers, EC members and all the members of the General Body, requested the President to Chair and conduct the meeting. Further, he also requested the members to actively participate in the meeting and offer their valuable suggestions in the interest of bettering the activities of Alumni Association.

2. Condolence to the departed Souls of Alumni members

3. To read the meeting notice calling for the 41st Annual General Body Meeting of the Association for the year 2023-24

The Secretary read out the meeting notice dated 07th March 2025 calling for 41st AGB Meeting of the Alumni Association for the year 2023-24.

4. Confirmation of the proceedings of the 40th Annual General Body Meeting for the year 2022-23 held on 16-12-2023 and the action taken thereon

The Secretary presented the proceedings of the 40th AGB meeting held on 16-12-2023 and the action taken report before the august body and requested to confirm the same.

Dr. V. Veerabhadriah, Former President of Alumni Association had said that the paneling has to be done for the Auditorium to avoid disturbances in sound system. This was discussed in the previous AGB Meeting also. He suggested to explore the possibility of converting the Auditorium to sound proof Acoustic



system to avoid disturbances. The Secretary replied that the new sound system has been installed by replacing the old sound system. The Executive Committee has discussed and obtained the quotations for paneling and assured to review the cost incurred for the same and will do the needful as early as possible.

The President expressed his gratitude to Dr.S.V.Suresha, Vice-Chancellor of UAS(B) and Patron of the Alumni Association for allotting 3 acres of land at GKVK to construct the branch of Alumni Association at the main campus which includes facilities for sports and cultural activities, Faculty Club, Guest Rooms, Dining etc., Progressive planning and implementation is the need of the hour.

After the deliberate discussions, Dr. R. Bachegowda proposed for adoption which was seconded by Sri A.R. Ranganath. Thus the 40th AGB meeting proceedings were confirmed by the august body.

5. To consider and adopt the annual report of activities for the year 2023-24

The Secretary Dr.K.M.Harinikumar presented the annual report of activities for the year 2023-24.

Dr.V.Veerabhadraiah proposed Scholarships for two under graduate students studying B.V.Sc. at Veterinary College, Hebbal, Bangalore, two under-graduate students at Dairy Science College, Hebbal and Dr.M.G.Govindaiah also proposed to provide scholarship to students studying B.F.Sc. at Fisheries College, Mangalore. The President informed that he would take up the same in the coming Executive Committee meeting.

The President brought to the notice of the House that the Alumni Association has included UAS Campus School, Hebbal, Bengaluru, for sanction of scholarship to two poor students.

Dr. C. Aswath suggested to take up farmers activities and consultancy cell for farmers. The executive committee should take up policy decision in farmers activities.

Dr. V. Veerabhadraiah, Former President suggested to take up programmes like Agricultural

Food Day, World Environmental Day and World Science Day. He said that to help the farmers, the expert Alumni members should give suggestions in organizing programmes with the help of Government. He said that the Alumni Association has to collaborate in organizing the programmes and support financially for some programmes. The Alumni Association has to associate with the institutions in conducting the programmes. The President told that as per suggestion, “Agricultural Days” will be discussed in the Executive Committee and calendar of events will be published along with other regular programmes.

After the discussion, it was proposed for adoption by Dr. Eswarappa K and seconded by Sri.B.N. Aswathnarayana. The General Body unanimously adopted the annual report of activities for the year 2023-24.

6. To consider and adopt the audited statement of accounts for the year 2023-24

The Treasurer Dr. N.Niranjana Murthy, presented the audited statement of accounts as on 31.03.2024, pertaining to Receipts & Payments and Income & Expenditure accounts of both Administrative and Building Fund accounts, including Balance sheet. He requested the august body for approval of the audited statement.

Dr. V. Veerabhadraiah said that the amount collected towards Life Membership should be kept in Fixed Deposit and it should not be utilized for any other purpose. The Treasurer informed that the life membership amount collected has been kept in corpus fund.

Dr. C. Narayanaswamy said that the Alumni Association has purchased new Neelkamal plastic chairs by replacing the old plastic chairs. He questioned that have you auctioned the old plastic chairs. The amount collected after selling the old chairs has not mentioned in the account statement. The Treasurer said that the amount collected after selling the old chairs is mentioned in the receipts column under the head of miscellaneous income.

Sri. N. Gopal Gowda said that it has come to his notice that the Alumni life membership fee



collected from the students at the time of undergraduate admission every year is being increasing 10% by UAS(B). The Treasurer Dr. Niranjana Murthy said that the Alumni Association has already written a letter to the Registrar, UAS(B) stating that not to increase the Life Membership fee of Alumni Association every year at the time of undergraduate admission and said that to collect the fixed amount of Rs.500/- only.

Finally, Dr. K. S. Rajashekarappa, Member proposed for adoption of audited statement of accounts as on 31.03.2024 which was seconded by Sri. R.N. Bhaskar, Member. The house unanimously adopted the audited statement of accounts for the year 2023-24.

7. To appoint auditors for the year 2023-24 and fix their remuneration

The Treasurer proposed to continue the same Chartered Accountants to audit the accounts for the year 2024-25 and sought the approval of the house to look for a new Auditor in case the present Auditor refuses to continue due to Audit fee issue or his busy pre-occupation. The house gave consent unanimously to the proposal and suggested to take a right decision in the matter by the Executive Committee.

8. Budget proposal for the year 2024-25 and 2025-26

The Treasurer proposed the budget for the financial year 2024-25 and 2025-26 and sought for approval. Dr. V. Veerabhadraiah said that since the AGB meeting is convened in the month of March, 2025, the proposed budget for the year 2024-25 for approval may not be required at this juncture. However, the proposal was approved by the house.

The Treasurer explaining brought to the notice of the house that it is the general procedure and formality in all the Societies and Co-operatives to take approval of the Budget for the preceding year based on the expenditures of the current year. Finally, the house unanimously approved the budget proposals for the year 2024-25 and 2025-26.

After the discussion, Dr. B. Narayanaswamy proposed for adoption of budget proposal for the

year 2024-25 and 2025-26 and seconded by Dr. R.N. Bhaskar. The General Body unanimously adopted the annual report of activities for the year 2023-24.

9. Discussion on written proposals, if any, received by the Secretary

The Secretary informed the house that Alumni Association has received the following written proposals.

1) Dr. V. Veerabhadraiah, Former Director of Extension, UAS(B) and President, Alumni Association has written a letter dated: 18-03-2025 to the President, Alumni Association, Hebbal, Bangalore to take appropriate decision in this matter. He said that the Agriculture College was started in 1946 at Hebbal was a name associated with Agril. Education, Research and Extension for almost 100 years from 1899. With the establishment of KVA&FSU, entire Hebbal campus is occupied by them. Therefore, it is necessary to perpetuate the name, "Hebbal", proposed that the Agril. College at GKVK, South and North blocks must be named as Hebbal Agriculture College South and North Blocks.

He also said that when Late Prof. G.K. Veeresh was the Vice-Chancellor of UAS(B), he arranged to erect a huge rock in front of old Agricultural College building at Hebbal signifying that Rock withers and Soil is formed. He has suggested to shift this rock to GKVK campus with the help of the Estate Officer, UAS(B), GKVK and place it in front of Agriculture College, GKVK, Bangalore.

2) Dr. K.G. Banuprakash, Professor & Head, Dept. of Sericulture, College of Agriculture, GKVK, Bengaluru has written a letter to the Alumni Association to enhance the serving period of Executive Committee members from existing three years to either five or four years, which can help the team to build and act efficiently.

The body suggested that the executive committee has to serve for a period of three years only as per provisions of the present By-Laws of Alumni Association. This matter has to be discussed in the Special General Body meeting and to take the



opinion of all the Alumni Members to extend the period of executive committee from 3 years to 4 or 5 years and amendment has to be made in the By-Law.

3) Dr. Challaiah, Alumni Member requested us to write a letter to the Govt. of Karnataka and Govt. of India to purchase food grains from the farmers, process and sell through their own marketing shops to the consumers in our state and country. The body suggested to write a letter from the Alumni Association to help the farmers in this regard.

10. Any other subject with the permission of the chair

Dr. K. Jagadeeshwara, Executive Committee Member and Chairman of the Infrastructure and Fund Mobilization Committee said that the faculty wants to start Alumni Association Co-operative Society / Bank for overall development and benefit of the members and their families whose number has touched to around 18,000 approximately. All the guidelines, procedure have been worked out as per the co-operative act to start the Alumni Association Society or Sowhardha Society in the interest of the Alumni Members and sought for the approval of the House. Some members, quoting certain societies which are already facing problems requested the body and members to proceed very carefully and it does not come under the purview of the Alumni Association.

Dr. V. Veerabhadraiah, Former President, Alumni Association has proposed that a committee of Senior Alumni has to be constituted by the

Executive Committee of the Alumni Association to present the suggestions regarding Integrating Agricultural Universities in the State before the committee headed by Sri. Vijaya Bhaskar, IAS Retd.

11. Address by the President

The President addressing the house, said that he is very happy to see good attendance and participation in the AGB meeting. He said that enrolling of members under student category of UAS(B) is under process from 41st to 58th Convocation and it will be updated later in the august body. The President also appraised about the issuance of I.D. cards for Life Members. He further said that the Alumni Association is committed to associate in more number of service activities pertaining to members, students and farmers. The President thanked all the members for their co-operation, in conducting this 41st AGB meeting in a smooth and fair manner.

Proceedings of the Special General Body Meeting of the Alumni Association, UAS, Bengaluru held on 11-10-2025 at 1.30 p.m. at Prof G.K. Veeresh Auditorium, Alumni Association, UAS, Hebbal, Bengaluru.

1. Welcome

The Members of the Special General Body assembled at 1.30 P.M. The President noticed that there were less number of members present which was not meeting the requirement of quorum, as the requirement of quorum is 1/3rd of the total number of members as per the Bylaw. Hence, in the absence of quorum, the President adjourned the Special General Body Meeting and requested the members to reassemble at 1.45 p.m.

The Members of the Special General body re-assembled at 1.45 p.m. The President Dr.H.L. Harish declared the Special General Body Meeting open and requested the Secretary Dr. K.M. Harinikumar to start the agenda items for discussion. The Secretary read the meeting notice and it was recorded.

Dr. V.Veerabhadraiah, spoke about the lack of communication to the members regarding Felicitation Programme held in the morning and Special General Body Meeting Notice. The President replied that the Association has posted the Special General Body Meeting Notice to all the Members of the Association and also copies sent through WhatsApp, mail and SMS. The Felicitation Programme Invitation, Special General Body Meeting Notice with proposed amendments to By-laws through bulk SMS, WhatsApp and Email were received by majority of the members and all the members confirmed the same.

The proposed amendments were later presented by the Secretary to the Special General Body, one by one as per agenda.

II. Rules and Regulations

1) Membership

Membership application format – Page-4 Appendix-I

Dr. K.M. Harinikumar, Secretary proposed the revised Membership Application Format (Annexure-I) and sought for approval.

Sri. B.N. Aswathanarayana, suggested that the heading of the application format should be changed as “**Application for the Membership**” instead of “**Application for Membership**”. It was agreed to incorporate the changes with other minor modifications.

Sri. N. Gopala Gowda questioned that why the life membership fee needs to be increased from Rs. 500/- to Rs. 1,000/-. The President replied that the life membership fee has not been increased from a long time and similar organizations like IAT have increased to Rs.1,000/- and also the matter was discussed in UAS(B) at Board of Management meeting wherein the Board and the Vice-Chancellor who is the Chief Patron of the Alumni Association also have been apprised of our decision to increase the life membership fee of Alumni Association, UAS(B) and finally house accepted the proposed increase in the Life Membership Fees.

Sri. Devaraju suggested collecting the Aadhaar Card or Voter ID Card or any valid ID and address proof with self-attestation during the enrollment of membership which helps in correspondence to the new members. The Committee accepted his suggestion.

Sri.Prasad.T.M asked that whether a graduate from any institution can become the Institutional Member of Alumni Association. The Secretary replied that any Farm Universities or any Organization or any Institution related with agricultural and allied professional activities on payment of prescribed fee can become an Institutional Member.

Dr. H. Shivanna, Former Vice-Chancellor, UAS(B) told that since the Association is collecting the Life Membership fee from the students at the time of admission to Under-graduate course at UAS(B), do they not know about the Alumni Association objectives and activities. The Secretary informed that all the undergraduate students of



UAS(B) are being invited to attend the Programmes, Training and all related activities conducted by the Alumni Association. The Alumni Association is also providing fellowships to students during the first year itself which continues till they complete their degrees.

Dr.Niranjana Murthy, Treasurer replied that every year Alumni Association is providing RAWE Diaries for 4th year students of UAS(B) containing the activities of the Association. These diaries are useful to the students to record the important learnings during their village stay.

Dr.B.Krishnamurthy said that the Association is also providing financial support for organizing the Animal Health Campaigns at RAWEP villages every year.

The item was proposed for adoption by Sri.N. Gopala Gowda and seconded by Sri.Ramakrishna.

2. Page No.9, Sl.No.8(a)

Administration:

The administration and management of the Association shall vest with the Executive Committee. The term of the elected members of the Executive Committee shall be three years.

Proposed Amendment

Term of the Executive Committee

The administration and management of the Association shall vest with the Executive Committee. The term of the elected members of the Executive Committee shall be five years from the date of assuming the office.

This will come into effect from the date of approval in the Special General Body meeting and this Five Year term is applicable to the present Executive Committee.

Dr. K.M. Harinikumar, Secretary, proposed the Term of the Executive Committee from three years to five years.

Dr. Veerabhadraiah, V. questioned that what was the justification for extending the term of the Executive Committee from three to five years. He also questioned that the proposed amendments to Bye-laws in Reasons column that “The term extended as per the decision of Annual General Body Meeting held on 29-03-2025” though it was not

discussed in the last 41st Annual General Body Meeting.

The Secretary replied that it was discussed and recorded in the 41st AGB meeting proceedings. Dr. K.G. Banuprakash had written a letter to Alumni Association before 41st AGB meeting to enhance the serving period of the Executive Committee members from existing three years to either five or four years, thereby helping the Executive Committee to have ample time to complete the proposed pending works of the Alumni Association and he again clarified that the same reply was given by him during the 41st AGB meeting.

Sri.Prasad.T.M informed the house that he was present in the last 41st AGB meeting and it was suggested and proposed to increase the term of the Executive Committee from three to five years and at that time the house accepted the same.

The President informed the house that extending the term of the Executive Committee from three to five years was discussed in the last 41st AGB meeting. Therefore, the Executive Committee formed the following Sub-Committee consisting of Dr.B.V.Venkateshaiah, Vice-President of Alumni Association as Chairman; Dr.T.N.Venkat Reddy, Member; Sri Madhava Reddy, Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies as Member and Sri.A.Gopal, Member-Convener. The sub-committee has submitted a report implying that in the interest of the Association the term of the Executive Committee may be extended from three to five years for efficient and complete functioning of the Association.

Dr.H.L.Harish, President said that the Alumni Association has updated UAS(B) graduate students membership which is now about 18,000 Life members. The Association successfully issued the I.D Cards to the Alumni members who graduated during the 59th Convocation of UAS(B). He also stated that the contact details of the graduate student members and all the members are being updated.

The President expressed his gratitude to Dr.S.V.Suresha, Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor of UAS(B) and Chief Patron of the Alumni Association for allotting 3 acres of land at GKVK to construct



the branch of Alumni Association at the GKVK campus. Now, the Association has to get the land surveyed and enter into Lease Agreement with UAS(B) and prepare the building plan and work out the cost of building the proposed Agri Cultural Association(ACA) at GKVK, Bangalore campus.

The President also said that one of our Senior Alumni Dr. Krishna Ella from Bharat Biotech Limited has expressed his views to have Alumni Association in GKVK Campus and along with other alumni, would support this great cause.

Sri.Manjunath strongly advocated that the term of present Executive Committee has to be extended from the present term of three years to five years, since they have already initiated very important tasks such as updating the database of Life Members and allocation of three acres of land to Alumni Association building at GKVK Campus. Hence they are approaching for extension of present Executive Committee from three to five years for good cause where we all need to support the Executive Committee. He also expressed that only the present Executive Committee can complete this task and the extension of the term has to be given to the present committee.

Sri.N.Gopal Gowda said that the next elected body Executive Committee can serve for a period of Five years but not the present Executive Committee. Many members raised their voice and said that Mr. Manjunath has already justified.

Dr. Veerabhadraiah. V said that when any new amendment is proposed it should be considered as prospective and it should not be retrospective.

Dr. G. E. Eswarappa questioned that whether there is any provision in Karnataka Societies Registration Act to extend for another two years for the present Executive Committee.

Dr.T.N.Venkata Reddy informed the house that Alumni Association is registered under Societies Act and not Co-operative Society Act. In Karnataka various Associations and co-operative societies have incorporated the amendments to enhance the term in their tenure.

The proposed amendments have to be approved in the Special General Body Meeting and does not require approval in the AGM.

In this regard, Sri Madhava Reddy presently working as Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies again clarified that if the Special General Body agrees the proposed amendment, the present Executive Committee can continue for another two years.

Dr. Eswarappa mentioned that when he was one of the office bearer in Institute of Agricultural Technologists, upon the request of IAT, the Board of Management, UAHS, Shivamogga has agreed and allotted land for IAT and one of the Minister was invited for the Guddali Pooja. Later on, the new Executive Committee was formed and till now they have not started the construction work. Therefore, the house can consider the proposed Amendment to Bye-Laws to extend another two years for the present Executive Committee to take the possession of the land for construction of branch of Alumni Association building at UAS(B), GKVK and complete the construction of the building.

In the interest of the Alumni Association, if the present Executive Committee has determination and zeal, then we all should support to extend their term for another two years for the present Executive Committee to complete all the pending works and activities.

Finally, it was proposed for adoption by Sri. Manjunath and seconded by Dr.Rajashekarappa.

3. Page No.9, Sl.No.8(a)

Co-opted Members:

The Executive Committee in its meeting shall co-opt five life members from among those members who have not contested for the preceding election of the Association, for a three year term which in its opinion will be useful to the Executive Committee in the discharge of its duties and functions. They shall have the voting rights in the Executive Committee.

Both the elected and co-opted members only shall have the voting rights in the Executive Committee.

In the event of resignation of an Executive Committee member, the Executive Committee shall take the candidate who has secured the next highest number of votes than the one elected member of the Executive Committee at the 15th place.



Proposed Amendment

The Executive Committee shall co-opt five life members from among those members who have not contested for the preceding election of the Association, for a Five Year term which in its opinion will be useful to the Executive Committee and Alumni Association in the discharge of its duties and functions. While co-opting members, care shall be taken to co-opt Life Members of Alumni Association, UAS(B), who represent different areas like Progressive Farmers, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries, Banking, Agri. Graduate Farmers, Agri Entrepreneurs, Education Field, Central Government Organizations, State Government Organizations, NGO's, FPO's and other areas.

The process of co-option shall be initiated and completed as and when the requirement of co-opted members arise and shall be decided by the Executive Committee within six months. If the Executive Committee could not come to conclusion in selecting the alumni members for co-option, the office bearers have the discretion to nominate the members.

Both the elected and the co-opted members shall have the voting rights in the general decisions of the Executive Committee.

In case of voting for election or removal of any office bearer/s (on the grounds of No Confidence Motion), only the elected members shall have the voting rights.

In the event of arising of vacancies of elected EC members due to resignation / removal / death etc., the Executive Committee shall take the candidate/s who have secured the next highest number of votes than the one elected member of the EC at 15th place.

In the event of unanimous selection of the Executive Committee, the vacancy shall be filled up by the Executive Committee with the consent of the President for the remaining term following the guidelines for co-option. With the above suggestions, the amendments proposed by the Executive Committee were approved by the Special General Body.

Sri. Ravindra suggested to increase the Executive Committee Members from 15 to 20 Members. The

President replied that the pros and cons of this subject will be placed before the next Annual General Body for discussion and further decision.

Sri.Prasad.T.M suggested to include the co-opting members who represent from Dairy Sectors (Karnataka Milk Federation)

After the discussion, it was proposed for adoption by Mr. Aswathanarayana.B.N and seconded by Dr. Vadiraj.

Proposed for Amendment

Removal / Discontinuation of Office Bearers / Executive Committee Members (Not mentioned)

No confidence motion against Executive Committee member / office bearer can be brought before Executive Committee if the motion is supported by at least 50% of the EC members, furnishing the reasons for no confidence against the person. The explanation letter shall be served to the person against whom the No Confidence motion is proposed, calling for his/her reply to the allegations made against him/her giving 30 days time. After receiving the explanation letter, the Secretary (Joint Secretary in the absence of Secretary) shall call EC meeting within 30 days from the date of receiving the explanation letter from the person against whom No Confidence motion is submitted. The reply shall be placed before the EC and the person shall be removed from the committee or office, if majority of the members vote and reject the explanation submitted. If the reply is not submitted within 30 days, then the office bearer will be automatically removed. If the votes polled are equal, the President will have a casting vote. The office bearers who have been removed shall continue as EC member.

The Secretary read the above proposed amendment and sought for approval of the house.

Dr. G. E. Eswarappa suggested to make it 51% instead of 50% of the EC members furnishing the reasons for no confidence against the person, for which the house approved.

After the discussion, it was proposed for adoption by Dr. Mahadeva Murthy and seconded



by Dr. H. Shivanna, Former Vice-Chancellor of UAS(B).

2) Removal of Members by Resignation

Addition

Proposed for Amendment

Any life member who wishes to resign and submits resignation letter, the same shall be approved by the Executive Committee. If the member has not withdrawn his/her resignation letter within 30 days from the date of resignation letter, it is deemed to have been accepted.

The Secretary read the above proposed amendment and sought for approval of the house.

After the discussion, it was proposed for adoption by Sri. V. Ramanna- and seconded by Dr. B. Krishnamurthy.

6. III. Bylaws

– Page No. 18 5(d)

Expenditure up to Rs. One Lakh per item may be incurred with the approval of the Executive Committee. Expenditure exceeding Rs. One Lakh per item should be approved by the General Body. However, in emergent cases, expenditure can be incurred after approval by the Executive Committee and should be ratified by the General Body.

Proposed for Amendment

Expenditure up to **Rs. Five Lakhs** per item may be incurred with the approval of the Executive Committee. Expenditure exceeding **Rs. Five Lakhs** per item shall be approved by the General Body. However, in emergent cases, expenditure can be incurred after approval by the Executive Committee and shall be ratified by the General Body.

The Secretary read the above proposed amendment and sought for the approval of the house.

After the discussion, it was proposed for adoption by Mr. Puttaswamy Gowda and seconded by Mr. Ramaiah.
